1 SATURDAY CANADA DAY

Throughout July, let's give thanks to the Lord for Canada and pray that the freedoms the church still has today will be protected. Let's ask the Lord to make a way for the gospel to penetrate every area of society. May he pour out his Spirit upon our nation. (Isaiah 1-3)

2 SUNDAY FINDING THE HOPE

Please pray for much fruit from June FTH outreaches in Mount Royal and in Montmagny, QC. Please pray for fruitful August outreaches in the Montreal neighbourhood of Côte-des-Neiges, QC and in the Toronto neighbourhoods of North and East York, ON. May God's kingdom come! (Isaiah 4-6; 2 Chron. 26:9-23)

3 MONDAY RESTRICTED ACCESS

Please pray for a fruitful discipleship and evangelism training and for the safety of all who will attend. May attendees be encouraged to help others know what it means to be a Christian in this restricted nation. Pray for opportunities to share the good news of Jesus with others. (Psalms 81-83)

4 TUESDAY CANADA WILDFIRES

Let's pray for Canadians affected by this season of wildfires. May the Lord provide miraculously in every way that is needed. Let's pray for God's grace and blessing for all firefighters who so bravely help and for an end and recovery in every place affected by these fires. (2 Chron. 27-29)

5 WEDNESDAY ZAMBIA

POP. 19,000,000

Pray for the safe arrival of a shipment of gospel literature. These materials will be used to equip local believers with resources for evangelism and discipleship. We give thanks to the Lord for the opportunity to share the gospel with every home in the country. (2 Chron. 30-32)

6 THURSDAY RESTRICTED ACCESS

Christian workers ask for prayer that God would give a great harvest for his kingdom in this nation. May the Lord give his children wisdom to know how to speak to people about the love of God and about his son Jesus Christ. May the Lord reveal himself to people. (Isaiah 7-9)

7 FRIDAY BARBADOS

POP. 300,000

Please pray for open doors for the gospel of salvation in unreached communities. Pray for receptive hearts and please pray for the leadership of EHC Barbados that they would have wisdom and discernment as they carry out the mission of reaching lost people with the gospel. (Isaiah 10-12)

8 SATURDAY LIBERIA

POP. 5,200,000

Please pray for the residents of Banliguea who will be visited by an EHC team. Pray for hearts receptive to the gospel and for a fruitful outreach. Pray for Christians who will participate in the outreach and the follow-up work. May the Lord guide and protect them. (Isaiah 13-15)

9 SUNDAY UKRAINE

POP. 43,700,000

EHC leaders in Ukraine ask that we remember Ukrainians in prayer. Pray that a hunger for God and his presence would arise in their hearts. Pray for peace and an end to the suffering that is shaping millions of lives. May God work mightily through his people and be their comfort. (Isaiah 16-18)

10 MONDAY RESTRICTED ACCESS

Praise the Lord that four people from one family recently received Jesus as their Saviour. In this country, this decision is a great risk. Please keep this family in prayer, and others who find themselves in similar circumstances. May they grow in discipleship and be kept safe by the Lord. (Psalms 84-86)

11 TUESDAY MESSENGERS OF HOPE

A growing number of individuals use the Finding the Hope resources in personal witness and outreaches to their neighbourhoods. Let's pray that God will bless them with favour, guidance, and protection. May they know his presence. May the gospel bear much fruit. (Isaiah 19-21)

12 WEDNESDAY EHC CANADA

Please pray with us for the Lord's abundant provisions for EHC and Finding the Hope. We need a breakthrough on every level. May the Lord provide in every way for the capacity needed in the office and raise up additional supporting partners for the ministry. May he richly bless every staff member and their families. (Isaiah 22-24)

13 THURSDAY MYANMAR

POP. 57,000,000

The EHC team needs prayer for the training that will take place this month. This is an important time of preparation for evangelism outreaches and for follow-up work and discipleship. May people come to know the Lord as personal Saviour as a result of this important training. (Isaiah 25-27)

14 FRIDAY CZECHIA

POP. 10,700,000

EHC's team in Czechia is preparing materials to mobilize churches in evangelism and discipleship. Let's pray that God will grant them wisdom and clarity as they prepare these materials and encourage churches to go to every home in their communities with the gospel message. (Isaiah 28-30)

15 SATURDAY REPUBLIC OF THE CONGO POP. 5,400,000

Please pray for EHC's team, that the Lord would strengthen and guide them as they work to bring the gospel message to those who have historically been disadvantaged in their nation. Pray for churches to engage in partnership and continue to reach their neighbours and communities with the gospel. (Isaiah 31-33)

16 SUNDAY REVIVAL IN THE CANADIAN CHURCH

Let's pray often for revival to come to the church across Canada — for renewed devotion to the Lord, his Word, and his mission; for a renewed vision of the spiritual harvest and a deep commitment to reach lost people in our communities with the gospel of salvation in Christ. (Isaiah 34-36)

17 MONDAY SURINAME

POP. 600,000

Pray that Christians would have a deep desire to bring the gospel message those who have never heard the good news of salvation in Christ. May they remain faithful even when life is full of difficulties, and wholeheartedly trust in the Lord. (Psalms 87-90)

18 TUESDAY WORLD LEADERS

Let's pray often for world leaders as they respond to many crises, particularly for those assisting Ukraine and other nations across Eurasia. May they be humble before the Lord in all their responsibilities; may God surround them with competent advisors. (Isaiah 37-39)

19 WEDNESDAY HONDURAS

POP. 9,300,000

Pray that God's people would be renewed with a desire to bring the gospel to people in this nation. "Only the gospel can transform Honduras," says the EHC team. Pray for the protection of those going home to home, and for God's blessing on their families. (Isaiah 40-42)

20 THURSDAY THE WORLD

Let's continue to ask the Lord to breathe his grace upon this broken world and awaken lost people everywhere to the reality of his boundless love and mercy. May the Lord intervene on behalf of people who suffer from all sorts of devastation and wars. May his kingdom come. (Isaiah 43-45)

21 FRIDAY RESTRICTED ACCESS

Please pray for more Christians to join this ministry. It is difficult to find those willing to labour for the gospel in this nation, so your prayers are urgently needed. May God bless those who serve sacrificially to reach those who have never heard the gospel of Christ. (Isaiah 46-48)

22 SATURDAY COSTA RICA

POP. 5,100,000

Please pray for the EHC team as they seek to help pastors and churches continue doing the work of evangelism throughout the country. Pray for labourers to come alongside those who are weary, and may God protect those who are engaged in this work for him. (Isaiah 49-51)

23 SUNDAY PAPUA NEW GUINEA

POP. 7,300,000

Praise God for the safe arrival of 20 volunteers who will be attending EHC's Discipleship Training School for six months. Pray that these Christians will grow in the knowledge of the Lord and be prepared to take on the challenge of bringing the gospel message to every home. (Isaiah 52-54)

24 MONDAY LITHUANIA

POP. 2,700,000

Please pray for the Lithuanian people to be receptive to the gospel message. Please pray for revival and for a great harvest from EHC outreaches. Pray that the workers would be many and that churches would be united in their efforts to reach people with the gospel of Christ. (Psalms 91-93)

25 TUESDAY RESTRICTED ACCESS

The government is cracking down on handing out gospel literature. Please pray that all bans would be lifted and that believers would be able to go to every home with the gospel message. Please pray for the protection of Christians in this restricted nation. (Isaiah 55-57)

26 WEDNESDAY SENEGAL

POP. 16,000,000

The EHC workers will be engaging in critical leadership training in the coming weeks. Pray for their protection as they travel across the country, for a successful and meaningful time with Christians, and a safe return to their families. (Isaiah 58-60)

27 THURSDAY CANADA

POP. 37,900,000

Let's lift our nation to the Lord in prayer and ask him for an outpouring of his Holy Spirit upon the over 38 million people who live here, awakening them to the reality of God's love and mercy and to their personal need of salvation. May God's kingdom come in our nation. (Isaiah 61-63)

28 FRIDAY RESTRICTED ACCESS

Praise God that Christians in this nation have been able to connect with a new district. Please pray for growing relationships with churches there, that God would bless this new connection and that these burgeoning partnerships would serve to bring many into the kingdom of God. (Isaiah 64-66)

29 SATURDAY GERMANY

POP. 79,900,000

EHC's team is focussing their outreach in the region of Eifel this year. Up to 1 million people are living there in rural conditions with few churches. Christians will share the gospel with as many people as possible. Please pray for a fruitful harvest to the glory of God. (Hosea 1-3)

30 SUNDAY CHILDREN TRAUMATIZED BY WAR

Pray for children being traumatized by the devastation of war in many nations, including Ukraine. May the Lord reveal himself to them, heal their trauma and fill them with hope. May they experience the love of Christ deep in their hearts and may their day-to-day needs be met. (Hosea 4-6)

31 MONDAY FINLAND

POP. 5,500,000

Many tiny cities dot the landscape of Finland, often far from one another. EHC workers ask for prayer as they travel to many cities to encourage churches in evangelism. They report that there is a lot of disappointment and hopelessness in these communities. They need the Lord. (Psalms 94-96)
